

# A Proposed Amendment to ensure fidelity to the U.S. Constitution by all those Privileged to serve under it

**Whereas:** The Constitution is the very Definition of the United States of America and thus all who serve under it are required to take an Oath of Office that they will, to the best of their Ability, preserve, protect and defend the Constitution of the United States.

**Whereas:** Since 1788 many Members of Congress and most Administrations have inflicted upon the American people Hundreds of Unconstitutional Laws, Regulations, and Executive Orders, causing untold Sufferings to all. These Sufferings lasting as long as it took for the afflicted people to mount a defense through a very costly legal system up to the Supreme Court often taking years for the Unconstitutional act to be corrected.

**Whereas:** Those Responsible for these Unconstitutional acts by definition have, with reckless disregard for their Oath of Office and Depraved Indifference to the Sufferings they inflict upon the American People, worked with immunity, individually and in mass, to Attack, Weaken, and Destroy, the Constitution and with it the Freedoms and Rights that it protects.

**Therefore:** The number of Unconstitutional acts and the duration of Suffering under them must be reduced and all those who have participated in the Creation, Passage, or Continued Infliction of Unconstitutional acts must be held to account for their Willful and Undeniable Violations of their Oath of Office.

**Therefore:** *We the People* propose the following Amendment to the U.S. Constitution in order to ensure fidelity by all who serve under it by making the Privilege to Serve contingent upon all who do continually answering the following question in the affirmative:

“Is what I want to do, been asked to do, or about to do today Constitutional?”

## The Constitutional Accountability Amendment

*“In the event that the Supreme Court finds any Congressional Legislation, Administration Regulation, or Executive Order to be Unconstitutional, all persons having written, sponsored, voted to pass, or signed into law, said Unconstitutional legislation, regulation, or Executive Order shall be deemed ineligible in perpetuity for any future elected, appointed, or hired position or office established or funded by this Constitution. Additionally said persons shall be subject to immediate removal from office at the sole discretion of their home state legislature or in the case of members of the Administration, via a two-thirds vote of the House of Representatives.”*

The Constitution is a contract entered into amongst the several States thus it is incumbent upon the States to ensure adherence to this Contract. When  $\frac{3}{4}$  of the States pre-ratify this Amendment the Federal Congress and the Executive will be compelled to enact it.
